





More Mission


Riviera's adopted third grade class at Frances S. Tucker Elementary School in Coconut Grove received a summer send-off from the Church with books from the summer reading list. The book distribution capped off a year of service to the 48 students including gifts of schools supplies in August, holiday gifts in December and Thanksgiving/spring break meal support for students in need. We also hosted the schoolwide Teacher Appreciation Breakfast in May. Riviera knows that when you educate a child, you change the world. Our work supporting this multi-ethnic school population with students from a predominantly economically disadvantaged community allows us to show God's love to the community. We will continue to follow this class into the 4th grade and will be calling on you for school supplies soon! After the recent shootings in Virginia Beach, Riviera responded with action in addition to our prayers.
