

Mission News...

Our potluck lunch for October was hosted by the Mission Committee and included Table Talk on the Ten Commandments of Food. We gave thanks for our food with the Addams Family Grace (earworm warning!) and talked about use of local foods in our diet and the impact of food choices. A surprising fact: Ruminants, of which cattle are the most common, accounted for nearly half of all agricultural production-related greenhouse gas emissions in 2010. If cattle were able to form their own nation, they would rank third behind China and the United States among the world's largest greenhouse gas emitters.

Talk turned to action as we wrote postcards to Wendy's urging them to join the Fair Food Program and to Senator Rick Scott asking him to support the Global Nutrition Resolution (H.Res.189/S.Res.260) and increasing global nutrition funding to \$150 million in the fiscal year 2020 appropriations bill. The bipartisan Global Nutrition Resolution recognizes the importance of continued U.S. leader-





ship to accelerate global progress against maternal and child malnutrition.



THEOLOGY UNCORKED


Theology Uncorked will meet on Sunday, November 10th at 5:00 pm at Titanic Restaurant and Brewery, where we wrestle with issues of social concern.
