Frances Tucker Elementary School Backpacks

Riviera Presbyterian Church started a ministry in 2016 filling and distributing backpacks to the first grade at Frances Tucker Elementary at the start of the school year. We continued that ministry every year following the original class. This year the children are starting the fifth grade.



Frances Tucker Elementary is a Title One school where the majority of the children come from economically disadvantaged homes or are in foster care. Currently there are 52 children registered for the fifth grade so the need is greater than ever.

In the past we would have distributed backpacks to the congregation and asked them to be filled according to the list provided by the school. This year, because of the pandemic, that is not possible. The Mission committee has been collecting the supplies on the current fifth grade list when they are

either available or on sale.



Each backpack costs about \$50 to assemble.



There is currently a donation line on the GIVE page for backpacks. Please consider giving \$50 per each bag that you would normally fill or whatever you are able to give towards the expense.

We can have church anywhere!



Hall doors. They will be picked up by a staff member.



The fates and futures of South Florida's ocean and Everglades environments are deeply intertwined. We cannot save one without the other. Ocean Conservancy has released a three-part documentary film series telling this story.

On Earth Day 2019 in Miami, as the official Ocean Partner of the Miami Super Bowl Host Committee, Ocean Conservancy joined the Miami Super Bowl Host Committee and Everglades Foundation to launch a new initiative to tell the story of the connections between South Florida's ocean and Everglades environments: Ocean to Everglades.

Deposit your used electronics in the recycling bin located outside the Fellowship Hall on the Sunset side of the building.


Riviera Church provides this recycling opportunity as part of its work as an Earth Care Congregation. We are committed to caring for God's earth.

NORMALIZING GUN SAFETY

Even as we maintain our "Safer at Home" social distancing, your Session is upgrading our church signage to include notices at the entrances that

proclaim "No Guns in God's House" in an effort to promote gun safety. As we recently learned from PCUSA's Rev. Deanna Hollis (the first-known Minister of Gun Violence Prevention) in a Zoom discussion of the film Trigger, normalizing a culture of gun safety is one form of gun violence prevention. It is with the hope that the signs will be posted at the entrances to the church property.
