Dear Riviera family,

Happy Easter!... We are an easter people! But not quite yet. How quickly we want to move to Easter. But before we do, we must spend the first few days of this month observing Maundy Thursday and Good Friday.

And in this time of COVID, when we are exhausted and so ready for our lives to return to some semblance of what it was 13 months ago.... we really do not want to take the emotional dive that these two days in the Christian calendar force us to make. We want to focus instead on the joy and promise of Easter. But it is also important for us to really understand in our hearts the whole Jesus story... it is important for us to focus on how the events of Holy Week could happen and important for us to make Jesus's betrayal and death our own story so that we can experience the true meaning of Easter.

I have told some of you that, for me, Maundy Thursday is enough. I can't quite get past the horror of it. This is the day when Jesus' inner circle,the people who gave up their former lives to follow him.... and celebrated him just a few days earlier in a parade..... then abandoned him denied him and betrayed him. Their actions on Maundy Thursday led to his crucifixion and death of the next afternoon. Could I be like them? Am I like them? And deep down I know that I am.... and I also know that I am forgiven just as they were. Love and forgiveness like that is powerful stuff!

Happy Easter!.... We are an Easter people! We live with the knowledge that we are loved and are God's both now and in life everlasting. We live with the promise that death is not the final word. We can live with that joy and assurance.

And we will celebrate Easter together. We have learned that even in this pandemic, when we must only worship online, we are still only a screen apart. The power of Easter cannot be diminished by a virus.

And our ministry at Riviera continues! This month we will also celebrate Earth Day and our call to earth care ministries. The Child Care Center will have their yearly food drive for the Food Pantry. And we will continue to be Christ's body, doing Christ's ministry and spreading the message of love. Happy Easter! We are an Easter people!





Due to social distancing measures that OneBlood has in place, please make an appointment by clicking on the box above.








Children's Sunday School Book Club


