

**Expectant waiting and preparation**. The season of Advent is here and Riviera began Advent with the lighting of the first candle on Sunday, November 28 – the candle signifying

"**Hope**." On a day to day basis, we all hope for this and for that ... big stuff like I *hope* I get the job, a raise, I hope my car doesn't break down; or I hope I can stay healthy during this crazy time. We hope for small stuff, too, like I hope this pizza is tasty; I hope it doesn't rain again today; or I hope these pants still fit (too many pizzas).

Whoosh those thoughts out of your head and wrap your mind around the **hope** that the birth of Jesus will once again signify the beginning of a better time. Someone we lean on, speak to, seek out, emulate and embrace.
