

Beloved Friends,

Blessed New Year to you! The Christmas Season feels like it's only just behind us, and already the season of Lent is quickly approaching.

This is a time when we often adopt a spiritual discipline that will inform and shape our journey through the holy season. This year, in the weeks leading up to Ash Wednesday, we will spend time exploring spiritual disciplines in worship. These interactive worship services are a chance for each of us to "Try On" different disciplines, with the hope that we will be inspired to commit to one - or more - for the 40 days of Lent. Please remember that donations are always welcome at the LEAP Dragonfly Thrift Boutique, 3141 SW 8th St, and bicycles for transportation are needed also.






