What is Theology Uncorked??

For generations thoughtful people of faith have gathered in public houses to share ideas, questions, and doubts about matters of life and spirit. One of the earliest and most legendary of these gatherings was the Inklings, formed in Oxford, England in the early 20th century. The Inklings counted among their members C.S. Lewis and J.R.R. Tolkien. The group met at a Pub called the Eagle and Child just off the campus of Oxford University for over 20 years. They were famous on campus and in the pub for their deep and wide-ranging conversations about faith, literature, philosophy, and role of humankind in the Universe. Theology Uncorked follows in this tradition.

Our friends at PubTheology.com describe it this way:

"The format is simple - beer, conversation, and God [and we at Riviera use these terms in the broadest sense imaginable!]. Come bring your questions, your curiosity, and pull up a chair. Be ready to engage with people of varying religious traditions, philosophical perspectives and life experiences. You'll be able to share your own wrestlings and thoughts while learning something new along the way, and there's likely to be a good craft beer you haven't tried yet!"
